Deadline extended to Monday March 14, 2016 Call for Posters

The Johnson Center for Innovation and Translational Research scientific program committee is inviting abstract submissions to present a poster during the Second Annual Bloomington Innovation Conference on Thursday, March 31, 2016. This conference will focus on cutting-edge research on the IU Bloomington campus that has potential to lead to commercial applications. Presenters will have the opportunity to receive feedback on their work through discussions with attendees from both the Bloomington campus and regional industry partners.

Poster submissions will be accepted from any area and may describe recently completed work or results of work in progress. Poster submission applications must include a maximum 500 word abstract. A draft of the poster may be included if desired. Please prepare your poster in either portrait or landscape format with the following maximum dimensions: 36" x 46".

The presenting author submitting an abstract must register for the 2016 conference. All authors whose abstracts have been accepted are responsible for costs associated with preparation and presentation of the abstract and poster.

The abstract submission timeline is:

- **Friday March 14, 2016:** Abstracts to be submitted through JCITR@indiana.edu in PDF format and must include your full name, university or industry affiliation, email address and phone number.
- **Monday March 15, 2016:** Abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee.
- **Week commencing March 21, 2016:** Authors will be notified if their abstract has been accepted to be displayed at the Second Annual Bloomington Innovation Conference.
- **Friday, March 24, 2016:** All accepted authors must have registered to attend the 2016 Second Annual Bloomington Innovation Conference. If registration is not received before this date it is assumed the author has withdrawn their abstract.
- **Thursday, March 31, 2016:** Accepted posters will be presented during the conference poster session.
